Minda Hills has been breeding superior Perendale cross sheep on our own account for many years, with considerable improvement in constitution, survivability and meat yield.


Yield via Scan from our progeny test at Alliance is currently sitting at 57% which is 4% above the national average.

We continue to work diligently on feet, wool and black points. Great progress is being made in breeding for a clear triangle around the anus – no one likes dagging! Our rams are reared in a commercial environment so are tested in adverse conditions. Only the best make the grade.

We are very excited with our continual improvement utilising many different types of proven and applicable technology. This helps us record the best genotypes to select from. We also continue the strong selection pressure on phenotype. (The animal still has to look good)
